HISTORY FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH TARBORO, NORTH CAROLINA

Prior to 1819 there was a considerable number of Baptists in Tarboro but they had no church and no regular meeting place. For several years they met in "The Public Meeting House" hearing sermons by visiting ministers; however, there were frequent conflicts with services held by Episcopalians. The Baptist would then meet in the old academy or in the carpenter's shop belonging to a Mr. McWilliams.

On February 6, 1819, at a conference held in Tarboro, a Baptist Church was constituted. Six people - Samuel Smith, Eli Porter, Peter P. Lawrence, Mamie Joyner, Navey Blake, and Ann Lawrence - were dismissed from their respective churches at Conetoe and Cross Roads to form the church under the leadership of Elders Joshua Lawrence, Martin Ross, Thomas Billings and Thomas Meredith. Mr. Meredith was to become the founder of the "Baptist Interpreter" (now the "Biblical Recorder"). He was also one of the fourteen fathers who founded the Baptist State Convention in 1830.

In a few years the "Tarborough Baptist Church" - by letters from nearby churches and by baptism - increased greatly in numbers and a house of worship was built on the banks of the Tar River near the present Quigless Clinic. Elder Joshua Lawrence, a native of Edgecombe County who frequently visited in Tarboro and preached, consented to become the pastor of the small congregation. At this time they were not known in Edgecombe County as Primitive or Missionary Baptist but were plain Baptist.

As the church increased in numbers and was in a "prosperous state", there was a wide difference of opinion among its members over missions. Elder Lawrence had serious threats made against his life for his strong opposition to the missionary cause. He ignored the threats and continued to preach, speaking his mind and frequently using as his text, "When they persecute you in one city, flee you into another, and Paul and Barnabas shook off the dust from their feet and departed."

To the regret of many of his followers, Mr. Lawrence did leave the church for a period of six to eight months. The church then called Elder P. W. Dowd of Raleigh who favored the missionary cause. Bitterness within the church became so strong that many who held to the older forms objected strenuously and gradually withdrew calling themselves Primitive Baptist. Just prior to the split, Eli Porter, one of the original founders, because of his prejudice against Sunday Schools and Mission Societies requested and received his church letter in June 1828.

It was on October 7, 1828, that the real climax came. At a called conference of the church, Elder Dowd was voted a dismissal from the pastoral care of the church and Joshua Lawrence was recalled to take up the work he had left before the controversy began. Soon after his dismissal, Mr. Dowd and his followers took over the meeting house which had just been constructed and members who were opposed to Missions and Sunday Schools were excluded.

At this point, Elder Lawrence was reported to have said, "Well and good, you may have the key but I shall keep the books"...which he did. The majority of the members feeling they could not have privileges as church members unless they had their records followed Mr. Lawrence. Having both records and consequently regaining the majority of the membership, Elder Lawrence reasserted his claim to the church property.

The missionary element, as soon as the split was effected in 1828, organized the Tarboro Missionary Baptist Church under the pastoral care of Elder Dowd. Mr. Dowd and his followers - nine members - built a meeting house near Hendricks Creek. This building and a stable lot were later sold to the Negro Primitive Baptist Church for \$200.00.

It was a time for organization and the leaders of the church caught the spirit that was awakening throughout the state. On February 10, 1830, the Tarboro Church sent representatives to Greenville, North Carolina, to assist in organizing the Baptist Benevolent Society, now known as the Baptist State Convention of North Carolina. Mr. Dowd was elected president and Henry Austin of Tarboro was elected treasurer. Mr. Austin had been received into the church in 1826 upon a statement of his experience and baptism by Dr. Rippon, pastor of a Baptist church in London, England. Also elected to the Board of Missions were many members from the Tarboro Church.

In 1834 Elder Dowd moved to Tennessee and from then until 1850, records of the activities of the church are incomplete. Prior to 1850 there was only one missionary Baptist church in Edgecombe County, but several were established later by the State Missions Board.

Elder Mack Bennett succeeded Mr. Down as pastor of the Tarboro church and in 1872 Rev. Thomas R. Owen took up the work. Rev. Owen and his wife also conducted a school in the county. Mr. Owen was so opposed to revivals that when Rev. George Green came to hold one, he left town.

At the time of Mr. Owen's ministry the church had become very weak. In 1876 it was reorganized in the home of C. J. Austin on East St. James Street, the site of the present St. James Methodist Church Educational Building. Rev. Joseph E. Carter succeeded Mr. Owen and during his pastorate, in 1890, O. C. Farrar and C. J. Austin were received into the church and shortly afterwards were made deacons. Rev. J. W. McManaway then took the pastorate, followed by Rev. J. A. Leslie.

When the second house of worship became unsuited to the needs of the church, the present lot on Main Street was given by Mr. Farrar and a new church house built. Rev. J. D. Hundley, following Mr. Leslie, was pastor when the new church was started. Although it was the desire of Mr. Farrar that on the day of the dedication, the church should be paid for, on the very day the church was to have been dedicated, Mr. Farrar's funeral was conducted.

The death of Mr. Farrar left the church heavily in debt as he was a man of means and contributed liberally to the support of his church. Mr. Hundley having left before completion of

the church was followed by Rev. J. D. Hufham, one of the foremost Baptists of the State. Because of the small membership - approximately twenty-five - Dr. Hufham was afraid the church would have to be sold but with determination he set about freeing it of debt. With much sacrifice on the part of individual members together with the assistance from Baptists of the State, the church was paid for.

During Dr. Hufham's ministry, the Mildred Church was organized in 1895. W. V. Savage followed Dr. Hufham and the church grew during the four years he was pastor. He was followed by N. S. Jones and Braxton Craig.

When this third church was sold to the St. Paul Baptist Church for \$4,000.00, it was moved across town in three sections and still stands in East Tarboro on the corner of Edmondson Avenue and Lloyd Street. The original organ which was bought for the church is in the present church parlor but is not used. Minutes during this time show membership was withdrawn for drunkenness, non-attendance at church, profanity, non-payment of debts, sanctification, and walking disorderly in contempt of the church.

After the resignation of Braxton Craig in 1901, Rev. T. S. Crutchfield was elected pastor. He was followed in 1903 by Rev. M. P. Davis. It was under the leadership of Rev. Davis' wife that the Woman's Missionary Union was organized. She also organized the first Sunbeam Band on October 2, 1904, and a young ladies group later known as the YWA. Since that time the influence of W.M.U. has been felt not only throughout all the activities of the church but also world wide by their support of missions. It was also during Mr. Davis' pastorate that the first young man from the church was ordained to the ministry. This was done by action at a meeting of the then Tar River Association in session in Weldon on October 26, 1904. The young man was Mitchell S. Harris.

On November 25, 1905, the Rev. C. W. Brooks became pastor serving until October 13, 1907. In that year a contract was made by the trustees of the church to build a single-story house on a part of the property back of the church facing St. John Street. The cost was not to exceed \$1600, to be paid by rental fees and building and loan shares carried by members. The note for the building of this house was paid on May 7, 1913, with Brother C. L. Fryer and Mr. Brooks burning the note in the presence of the congregation. Following removal of a two story house on the corner of Main and St. John Streets, which was the parsonage then, this new cottage was used for the parsonage and was first occupied as such by Rev. I.L. Yearby and his family. During erection of the present church building, a large wooden tabernacle, which had been built for a city-wide church revival, was used for services. Following Mr. Brooks, pastors were G. C. Harrill, A. V. Joyner, W. R. Alexander, and W. B. Daughtry. Rev. Daughtry, who became pastor in November 1913 served only two weeks, passing away suddenly.

On June 28, 1914, the church called the Rev. R. H. Bowden. Fred Cooper, Negro, gave the silver communion set and the pulpit furniture in addition to serving as janitor without a salary. (The pulpit furniture is not located in Friendship Hall.) Although there had been other Negro members previously, since his death in 1916 there have been no negro members. After

a period of ill health, Mr. Bowden resigned in 1917 and Rev. Jones E. Kirk became pastor. His family was the last to occupy the two story house and it was torn down in April 1923. It was during Mr. Kirk's pastorate that the church took a definite step forward when in conference on May 11, 1921, they voted to come off the North Carolina Mission Board from which they had received help and become self-supporting. The Board of Deacons who approved this step were C. L. Fryer, R. B. Josey, F. J. Warren, J. Frank Powell, W. C. Ranes, C. W. Austin, O. R. Pollard, C. D. Dobson and R. E. Sentelle. Members of the church now who were resident members when this action was taken in 1921 are J. C. Powell, Mrs. M. L. Laughlin and Mrs. W. C. Ranes.

In 1916 a mission Sunday School was started at Runnymede Mill, a mission was started in Pinetops, which is not a flourishing church, and the work at Mildred was revived.

The story of how the present church building was brought into being is characterized by vision, faith, courage, heroism and tireless work on the part of the pastor, Rev. I. L. Yearby, and the entire congregation. Mr. Yearby was called to the First Baptist Church in the spring of 1923. He came directly from the Southwestern Seminary where he had just graduated. In his first three sermons - "Why have you sent for me?", "God's will for the Baptist in Tarboro", and "Counting the Cost", he made it clear to the congregation he had a vision for the Tarboro Baptist Church which included a new house of worship adequate in every way to take care of a worthy religious educational program. Many people thought he was dreaming and that a new building such as he outlined was neither necessary nor possible.

A religious census of the town was taken which revealed that there were more that 750 people in Tarboro who were Baptist, Baptist-inclined, or who had no denominational preference. This was an eye-opener for many people and the Sunday School was graded on a departmental basis and teacher-training classes were conducted. As a result many new classes were formed and new pupils enrolled in the Sunday School. People soon began to see the inadequacy of the old building and on Sunday afternoon, August 30, 1924, a mass meeting of the entire membership of the church was called and the building proposition presented. This meeting resulted in the church's committing itself to a building program and the launching of a campaign to raise funds, setting as their goal \$60,000.00. On Sunday, September 7, pledges were secured in the amount of \$60,400.00.

In May 1926 the church decided to begin building operations and on July 20, 1926, ground was broken for the new building. Excavation was begun the following day, an agreement having been entered into with John W. Hudson, Jr., general contractor of Tarboro, to erect the building. As well as giving their money, members worked with their hands to help in the building of their new church. In the summer of 1926, almost every night after regular work hours, someone was at the site hauling and placing material. More than twenty-five carloads of brick were taken from railroad cars, hauled and stacked on the grounds by members of the church. Members with help from many friends raised the labor pay roll each week. The building was housed in and the roof on by Christmas and on December 26, the first service was held in the basement. At this point work was discontinued and nothing further done until

October 1927 at which time construction began again and continued until completed at a total cost of \$70,116.13.

On September 2, 1928, the church regretfully accepted the resignation of Mr. Yearby, who had accepted a call to the Earl St. Baptist Church in Greenville, S. C. Realizing the importance of meeting the balance of indebtedness of \$35,000 on the church, the committee and the church, on October 3, 1928, extended a call to J. Archie McIver of Louisburg. Much progress was made in the curtailment of the debt by the efforts of Mr. McIver. One Sunday, \$1,500 was brought in pennies by members including the children. It was during 1929, with much depression, indebtedness, and despair, that members mortgaged their homes to help make payments.

In October 1931, Mr. McIver tendered his resignation and in February 1932, Dr. Joseph L. Peacock of Raleigh, former President of Shaw University, became pastor serving until 1940. During his pastorate the debt was reduced and refinanced to cover a period of twenty years. (At his request Dr. Peacock made the final \$100 payment on the debt in 1944). When this much loved pastor retired in 1940, his assistant, the Rev. James Dockery Williams, a young graduate of the Louisville Seminary, assumed leadership. The main objective at this time, second only to winning souls by preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ, was the retirement of the debt balance.

The culmination of the twenty-year building program was observed on May 20, 1945, when the church met on Sunday morning and burned the mortgage indicating the present church was debt free and dedicated to the work of God's Kingdom. After a short sermon by the pastor, the great moment came for the people who had worked so hard and faithfully when the canceled document was given in the hand of the former pastor, Dr. Peacock, who had led them in some of their hardest years with great devotion and self sacrifice. Senior deacons F. J. Warren and C. L. Fryer; Emily Austin, church treasurer; and Dr. J. G. Raby, Finance Chairman through the years, participated in the burning of the mortgage while Dr. Peacock held the tray. (The ashes have been preserved). It was written that "During the burning the people joyfully sang the Doxology."

In May of the following year, 1946, the church voted to buy a Hammond electric organ to be delivered within four to six months. The approximate cost was \$2400. Also in 1946 Miss Virginia Beall was called as the first educational director.

After seven fruitful years of service, the Rev. J. D. Williams resigned effective October 4, 1947 and a call was extended to the Rev. Carl Lee Ousley in January 1948.

By 1949 the resident membership of the church had grown to 430 with a total membership of 604. It was during this year that a new mission was started. From the minutes of a business meeting held on September 7, 1949, we read the following: "Upon recommendation of the Board of Deacons and the Board of Finance, it was passed unanimously that Mr. Howard Knight be employed at Hart Village Mission for a salary of \$175.00 a month with the State Mission Board providing \$75.00 of this amount." Calvary Baptist Church of Asheville, on behalf of the First Baptist Church of Tarboro, ordained Howard C. Knight to the

ministry on July 26, 1950, upon his completion of school at Southeastern Seminary. Hart Village Mission was organized into a church on Sunday, November 12, 1950. Forty-six members of the First Baptist Church were granted letters to become members of the new church now known as Trinity Baptist Church.

Yet another step was taken on June 18, 1950. During a business meeting following the morning worship service, the congregation voted unanimously to employ a full-time minister of music. Miss Gazelle Moore served the church in this capacity.

For several years the congregation had recognized the need for a new parsonage and on May 21, 1951 the church voted to purchase the McDowell property on Panola Street for \$13,500. The cottage behind the church which had served as parsonage was turned over to the Women's Missionary Union. Renovated by the men of the church and furnished by the women, it became the first Ladies' Parlor with rooms in the back used as Sunday School rooms.

A Ten-Point Expansion Program was approved on September 7, 1952, and included breeze-conditioning the church, building six adult Sunday School classes; renovating Friendship Hall, painting the exterior of the church and buying needed furniture. With future expansion in mind, in April 1955, the church purchased a lot 58 feet by 88 feet from J. T. Hagans, Jr. for \$3,521.75 plus interest and taxes.

It was in July 1955 that the church received Mr. Ousley's resignation due to illness and conflict within the church. The Rev. Joseph S. Larrimore became pastor on May 15, 1956 and the following year the church began a long-range building program which included: educational building, kindergarten, educational director, elevator, air-conditioning sanctuary and parsonage.

The building program began on January 6, 1958, with the opening of the kindergarten and Day Nursery directed by Mrs. Elbert Stocks. In the spring of 1958 a lot at the corner of Clark and Roberson Drives in Forest Acres was purchased and the new parsonage constructed. It was early winter when the Larrimores moved into their new home.

The building program continued and on May 2, 1965, the new educational building which would house the children's departments - to age 8 - was dedicated. The building committee was composed of S. J. Bartholomew, Chairman; E. L. Stocks, J. B. Teal and J. C. Powell.

With deep regret, the church accepted Mr. Larrimore's resignation effective December 31, 1967. During the twelve years he was pastor the resident membership increased 118 to 636 with a total membership of 848. Dr. Kelly White served as interim pastor from January 1968 until January 1969 and brought the church together in love and fellowship and in prayer for a true man of God to lead us. That man - Rev. J. Monte Bishop - became our pastor on February 1, 1969.

In the spring of 1970 the church named the following committee for the purpose of renovating the sanctuary: Dr. T. S. Fleming, Chairman; Mrs. George Anderson, Mrs. John Craver, Mrs. E. D. Johnson, Mrs. Clayton Taylor, Mrs. H. V. Vick, Jeff Avery, Harry Newsome,

Lester Pollard, David Taylor, Gerald Ward and C. W. Wickham. Following a year of planning, work was begun in May 1971 to renovate the sanctuary and music suite and to install an elevator.

From May until November, services were held in the old Colonial Theatre. Appropriately enough, one of the first features showing during this time was "Preacher Man" and brought many chuckles - not only from Baptists but from other citizens. On December 5, 1971, the first service was held in the renovated sanctuary and on January 16, 1972, a dedication service was held.

The years of Mr. Bishop's ministry were some of the most fruitful in the history of the church. Resident membership increased from 669 to 1013. In addition to the renovation of the sanctuary, under Mr. Bishop's leadership the church purchased the Austin Property (1973) and the courthouse annex (1979); reorganized the radio ministry (1977) and began the cable ministry (1979); began a pre-school program (1979); installed new heating and air-conditioning (1976); purchased an Allen Organ (1972); began operation of library in its present location (1975); and purchased a van and bus to be used in the various programs of the church. In July of 1979, as an act of love, the parsonage was sold to Mr. Bishop for \$45,000.

In May of 1978 the Long Range Planning Committee adopted a resolution pointing out the need to provide for additional administrative space, space for recreational activities, and space for expansion of the overall program. The committee recommended immediate steps be taken to plan for the construction of a multiple-use educational facility on the property occupied by the annex and in 1982 the Family Life Center Committee was appointed to begin looking into the feasibility of planning and building a center.

Because of conflict within the church, on July 18, 1984, Mr. Bishop resigned his pastorate effective August 19, and a pulpit committee began the difficult task of replacing this dedicated man of God, Mr. Bishop was a true "shepherd to his flock" and his leaving was a great loss to the church and to the community. Rev. Clarence Godwin was called to lead during this most difficult time and did it with much love and caring.

After many months the pulpit committee felt they had found the man God had led them to and in July 1985, Dr. E. Lavelle Waters answered the church's call and set about the task of bringing the church together and moving forward with God's will for the church.

At the writing of this history the waters are still troubled and currents run deep with the work of God becoming second to personal feelings. Perhaps at this point, as we enter into a new era, it would be well to remember the words of the Reverent I. L. Yearby in his message to the church on June 3, 1928:

"As I entered upon this ministry with you, I had a vision for this church for which I have prayed to see accomplished. That vision is today fulfilled in part. I trust that the days that are to come will let us see it fully consummated. The struggles and sacrifices of the past have at times been hard

but always glorious because we were doing it for our Master. While we rejoice in what has already been accomplished, I remind you that our real task has just begun. We have a building in which we take great pride and rejoice but our work now is to build the church in the house. With this building completed our obligation is multiplied many fold. If we do not rise to please and honor God in the teaching of His word to all, in the training of Christians in His service, and in the winning of the lost to Christ, we shall be recreant to a holy mission and will court disaster and failure for the future. I plead with you that here and now, all of us shall put ourselves on the alter, in service to our Master, for the sake of the future success of our membership and the coming of the Kingdom of God in our community. God is counting on us. Jesus Christ is expecting great things of us, and a lost world is calling to us for light and life which can only be found in the Saviour. What shall be our response? Let us not disappoint any one."
