to our Receiver General by the Nation of Chowan Indians

 unto the Chief said Chowan Indians, a Tract of Lands  
 containing Eleven thousand and three hundred and sixty  
 according on the N. E. side of Chowan River, Bounding on  
 Patrick's Land of a Wye Branch to a Pine his Corner

Nation of Chowan Indians, their heirs and assigns  
Forever, Guiding and Paying unto us, our  
heirs and Successors, yearly, every 29<sup>th</sup> day of Sept<sup>r</sup>.  
the fee rent of one Ear of Corn, for every heire and  
Acres here by Granted, to be holden by us, our heirs  
and Successors, in feoffardiv<sup>o</sup> Common Peaceage  
Given under the Seal of the Colony, the fourth day of Sept<sup>r</sup>  
Ann. Dom<sup>o</sup> 1722. Witness our Trusty, and well beloved

Province and the rest of our Trusty, and well beloved  
Councillors, who hath hereunto set their hands
