Cherokee Chapter, Atlanta, Georgia

On September 22, 1971, Cherokee Chapter had the honor of marking the graves of a Revolutionary soldier and his daughter. This occasion was the culmination of a long and diligent search by the Registrar, Mrs. John W. Maltbie, and the Historian, Mrs. L. C. Buzzett, who located the graves on the old STRICKLAND property on Settlebridge Road in Gwinnett County, Georgia.

The property is now the home site known as "Lark-A-Bit Farm" owned by Mr. & Mrs. William Carnes and it was through the courtesy and cooperation of the present owners that this search was made possible. The graves were finally located in an inaccessible spot and were in remarkably good condition. The first one was marked "Thomas Connally, Soldier of the Revolution, Age 82" and the second one was marked "Polly Connally Strickland 1752-1810."

The markers were placed by the Regent, Mrs. Claude E. Fitts, assisted by Mrs. Maltbie, Mrs. Buzzett and Mrs. H. P. Barlow, Jr.

Note: Polly Connally of Franklin County, Georgia, m. WILSON STRICKLAND on 2 March 1809. Wilson was born 14 Jan. 1783 in NC, and died 10 Nov. 1841. He and his wife were members of Level Creek Methodist Episcopal Church. They were taken in by letter in the latter part of 1822 or early 1823. They had no children. They are buried in above ground vaults enclosed by an iron fence. Our records show Polly died 25 Feb. 1840 - Age 58.

JACOB STRICKLAND of Franklin County, Georgia Recorded 1842

This will of JACOB STRICKLAND was originally recorded in Franklin County, Georgia, and is printed on page 32 of Strickland Scene Vol. 1. The Georgia Senate "passed a bill to authorize Hardy Strickland of Forsyth County (Note: known as Chattahoochee Hard) executor of his brother, JACOB STRICKLAND late of Franklin Co., Ga. dec'd, to obtain from the clerk's office of the Court of Ordinary of Franklin County a copy of all the records concerning the estate of said JACOB STRICKLAND and have them recorded in the Clerk's Office of the Court of Ordinary of Forsyth County, and to make annual returns on said estate to the Court of Ordinary of Forsyth County."

## BIBLE RECORD

## Isaac Strickland of Upson County, Georgia

A copy of the family pages was made and submitted to Strickland Research, Inc. by H. G. Kenney from the Bible owned by R. H. Strickland of Concord, Georgia. The Bible was published in 1869. Many newspaper clippings and loose papers were located in the Isaac Strickland Bible. The newspaper clipping with the earliest date is reprinted below:

"Died of diarrhrea on the 21st of May, 1861, Berry, infant son of Isaac and Mary Strickland, being one year two months and 22 days old. Grieve not for him whom the Lord hath taken from the evils of this world and to be with himself where sorrows never come. On the night of the death of the child his mother was taken with the same disease and on the 29th she died.

Sister Mary Strickland, daughter of Henry and Polly Hartsfield and wife of Isaac Strickland, was born 28th Jan., 1821, and was baptised by brother Jacob King into the fellowship of old Bathesda Church near Thomaston, Upson County, on the 4th Sabbath in Feb., 1840. She lived a christian life, and died full of faith. She left a large family of children and many connexions and friends to mourn her death. She was emphatically a good wife, a good mother, a good mistress and a good neighbor, and her place in all these relations will be sensibly missed. It is useless to write eulogies of deceased persons for their neighbors, and strangers care for nothing of the sort. May her husband and children, connexion and friends all be prepared to meet her in heaven when it shall come to all our times to die. W. H.

Mary Elizabeth Sanders, P O Box 2122, Covington, LA 70434; Needs information on JOHN WESTON/WESSON MERCER/MESSER born in SC 1795-1798. He and his family were living in Jasper Co, GA by 1820 census. As soon as Henry Co. was formed, they moved there. By 1850, he had moved to Franklin Co, AL, where he died 31 May 1863.

His brothers and sisters were: Joseph (unm.); James; William; Samuel; a sister (name unknown) who m. Dennis M. Knowles; Patience, b. SC 1788 m. John Hand; Charity, m. David King. The Mercer siblings are thought to be children of WILLIAM MERCER and his wife MARTHA. WILLIAM MERCER died testate in 1818 in Jasper Co, GA, but the book containing his will has disappeared.

JOHN W. MERCER/MESSER m. (1) a Miss Hand, by whom he had several children; after her death he married (2) ANN M. STRICKLAND b. in GA. in 1800.
