EDITOR'S LETTER


Dear Members,

OCTOBER 1664 DEPOSITION OF ELIZABETH STRICKLAND (b. ca. 1639)
OF CHARLES CITY COUNTY, VIRGINIA

From Charles City County, Court Orders, 1664-1665, p. 518:

"The deposicon of Elizabeth Strickld aged 25 yeares or thereabouts sworne and exa'ied this 27th day of 8'ber A'om 1664. Saith That this depon't being a sojourner at Mr Rice Hoes house about four yeares since and useing both dwelling house and Quartering house day time and Evening this depon't deposed that she nev'r saw any hoggs brought in by him or his serv'ts unlesse they were his owne to be killed nor any hoggs w'thout eares and further this depont deposeth that she nev'r see Mrs Susan Hoe not to wrong any person and likewise deposeth that she nev'r saw in any Chest of Mrs Hoes any Linning but what was her owne so farr as I know nor yett any where else in the house and further deposeth that she nev'r heard of any such thing by any of the serv'ts by hoggs or any other goods and further saith not. her Elizabeth S Strickld marke Jurat' Coram me Thomas Drewe"

M. B. STRICKLAND (1835 -) OF ST. CLAIR COUNTY, MISSOURI

M. B. Strickland was born 8 Aug 1835 in Franklin Co MO, the son of E. B. Strickland, a Georgia native, and Sarah K. Caldwell, a Kentucky native. E. B. Strickland was an early settler of Franklin Co MO. M. B. married Miss Mary Conway, daughter of Samuel Conway, on 5 May 1857 in St. Louis Co MO, her county of birth. M. B. resided in Franklin Co MO from the time of his marriage until March 1877, when he moved to a farm in St. Clair County, where (perhaps at a later date) he had 480 acres "improved" land. In 1882 he was elected to represent St. Clair County in the Missouri legislature. He and his wife had five children: Virgil C., Virginia S., Ada L. and James L. M. B., his wife and oldest daughter were members of the Presbyterian Church.

ABSTRACTS OF THREE MISSOURI WILLS & ADMINISTRATIONS NAMING STRICKLANDS

Will of Samuel Wood, dated 8 Jan 1845, proved 15 Feb 1845 in Dade Co MO. Names wife Susannah Wood, son William A. Wood, dtr Ann Brickey, dtr Sarah Ann Strickland, & dtr Delilah Strickland. Executors were wife Susannah Wood and son William A. Wood. Witnesses were Decatur Dewey and Luke Stricklin. (Wills pp.47-49)

Luke B. Strickland died intestate in Dade Co MO. Jeffrey H. Woolfington was named administrator of his estate on 22 Nov 1853. (Administrations p.102)

James W. Strickland died intestate in Laclede Co MO. Eliza J. Strickland & C. C. Lovelace were named administrators on 13 Aug 1860 (Adm. p.120). Christian Lovelace was identified as "administrator debonis non" 11 Feb 1865 (Adm. p.244).

REFERENCES TO TWO LANDOWNING STRICKLANDS OF JACKSON & JEFFERSON COUNTIES, MISSOURI

From property descriptions of lands of George C. Sibley sold at a Jackson Co MO sheriff's sale 26 May 1828, published at the time in The Jeffersonian, a newspaper printed in the City of Jefferson: The 2d parcel was 800 acres situated on Platin Creek above Horines Mill in Jefferson Co, originally granted to John Dowling, lying in Township 40 North in Ranges 5 & 6, east of the 5th principal Meridian, bounded on the north by part of Survey 1915 in the name of John A. Sturges "under Titus Strickland" (=?), on East by survey no. 1854 in name of Jesse Dowling, south by no. 859 in name of Carlin's widow. Sold to Allen for \$1,600.00.

William Strickland and wife Catherine on 20 Mar 1832 sold James Temple 80 acres, the west 1/2 of the SW quarter of Setion 25, Township 50, Range 31, recorded in Jackson Co MO at p.48 1 Jun 1832.

SIGNATURE OF WILLIAM STRICKLING OF ROBERTSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE ON 1813 PETITION

The signature of William Strickling appears among five pages of signatures on an 1813 petition (numbered 32-1-1813) of the citizens of Robertson Co TN concerning assessment of federal taxes that were to be collected by the state from every county. They ask for commissioners who will be fair in their apportions.

Minutes - Superintendent of Common Schools: Evan H. Morgan, Zadoc Strickland & Jacob Strickland elected committeemen for District 20 (year 1843?), p.21; Allison Strickland appointed inspector of school committee election for District 32 (year 1853), (toward end of book, no page number).

Nash County Election Records: William D. Strickland was one of three committeemen elected for District 20 in the year 1851; the list of voters includes Zadock, Watson and William D. Strickland.

Jury Tickets (Jury Lists) File: Sampson, Zadock and Warren Strickland named (undated).

Nash County Officials' Appointments: R. W. Strickland appointed in 1853 as overseer of the road from the county line to William Frazier's, with the hands of Jacob, Zadoc, Redding, William, Madison & John Strickland and others. Eli Strickland appointed in 1852 as overseer of the road from the Raleigh Road near widow Brantley's to Green land near Leigh's Chapel Church with the hands of Redding & Calvin Strickland and others. Alison Strickland's hands were assigned in 1852 to work under supervision of Uriah Crickmore on the road from Bassville to the Franklin County line toward Andrews Bridge. Hands of Jacob, Zadock, Madison, Matthew, Redding & C. O. Strickland were assigned in 1856 to work under John Morgan on the road from the Franklin line to William Frazier's.

Nash County School Records (From 1840's): Stricklands appearing as school-aged (over 5, under 21) in lists for the common schools: Condary O., Alison, Redden, Charity, Noah, Jane, Nancy, Sarah, Elizabeth, Lany, M. M. C. K. (female), C. M. J. (male), Susannah, Mahala, F. K. W., William G. N. Z. A., John W. W. R., Simon, Bryant and Figurs (?).

1866 MIGRATION OF ATTALA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI STRICKLANDS TO POLK COUNTY, ARKANSAS

An eight wagon train, the first two horse-drawn belonging to leader Jason Harrison (8 Jan 1809 - 6 Jul 1886), and the others ox-drawn, started for Texas from Kosciusko, Attala Co MS in December 1866. His wife, nee Mary Hutchens (b. 25 Oct 1808), had died and was buried in MS. Others in the train included: Jason's unmarried children Taylor and Mary Harrison; Green Conn, age 24; Solomon Kemp, his wife Sarah (daughter of Jason Harrison), and their children; Hizzie Harrison, who was a Methodist minister & a son of Jason, with his wife and grown children; Mr. Strickland and his wife, who was the daughter of Hizzie Harrison; Tom Harris, his wife Ebbie, who was a daughter of Jason, and their three children; Andrew Jack Strickland, his wife Adlizar Harrison, who was a daughter of Jason and the twin of William Harrison, and their children; Marion Harrison, who was a son of Jason, with his wife, nee Martha L. Strickland, who was the sister of Andrew Jack Strickland, and Marion's and Martha's eldest daughter, who was married to Lincoln Felt.

The wagon train stopped at Little Rock AR during the Christmas holidays, then moved slowly on and camped on the Caddo River, and next near Cherry Hill in Polk Co, where seven year old Mary Harris, daughter of Tom and Ebbie, died, followed by Mary's twelve ear old brother Jason about two weeks later. The site they were buried is now known as Liberty Cemetery. The wagon train discontinued its trek there, though Hizzie Harrison followed his ministerial calling to Texas with his daughter who married a Strickland.

The Andrew Jack Strickland family settled and farmed at Board Camp. Descendants of this family in Polk Co include the Medfords, Bains, and Mosses. J. F. Strickland, who was five years old when the wagon train arrived in Polk Co, married Annie Hilton. Their son Frank Strickland had children Marie, Orlan, Fredda, J. W., Dorothy and Don.

Lincoln Felt and his wife moved to Oklahoma Territory. Their son, Lincoln Felt, Jr., lived in Tulsa after retirement as a railroad detective.

The five children of Joseph Marion Harrison and Martha L. Strickland were Berry, Joseph, George Madison, Mary A. and Henrietta.

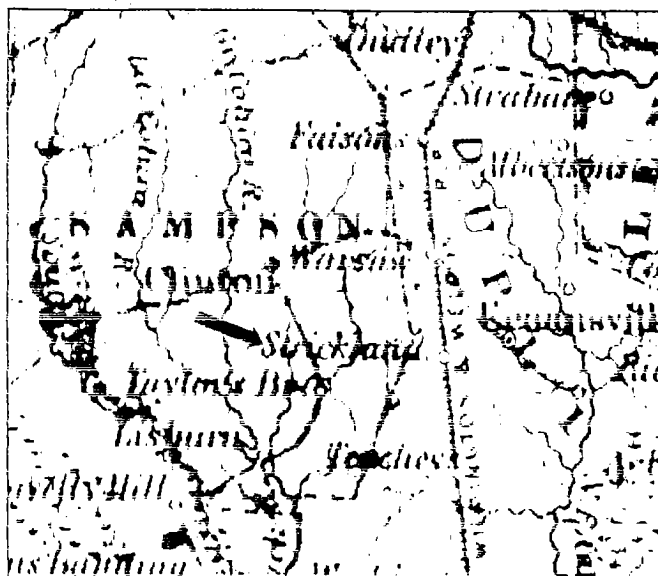

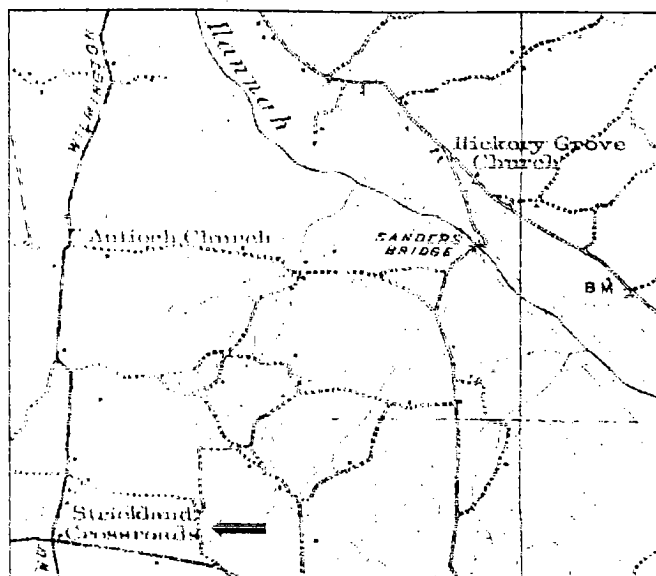

SPENCER 20860: I am searching for the ancestors of Elizabeth Strickland, b. ca. 1809, who married Allen Spencer, b. 1802, d. 1882. They lived in Jasper, Steuben Co NY, and are the parents of Adoniam Judson Spencer, b. 1840, their 2d child, who was my grandfather. Their 1st child died young. In 1810 a William Strickland was in Washington Co NY, from which the Spencers came, and a Daniel Strickland in Steuben Co NY where the Spencers were. STRICKLING James E. Strickling, 5705 DeKalb Lane, Norcross GA 30093: Who were
STRICKLAND the parents of Henry Strickling, b. 1818 GA? (This spelling was used
HOUSE by all of his children and most of his descendants.) His parents are believed to have been born in GA. He married Lucina ?, b. 1817 GA, believed to have been the d/o John House, believed to have been b. ca. 1786 SC. John House is believed to have had sons named Burell and Jameson/Jamerson/Jemison. Henry Strickling is first seen on the 1840 census of Cherokee Co GA; his oldest child was born there in 1837. In 1850 he was in Benton (now Calhoun Co) AL. From 1860 until his death sometime after 1900, Henry was in Cherokee Co AL. Henry's sons who left descendants were: George W. (Wesley?), b. 1837 GA; Francis Marion, b. 1840 GA; Irvin C., b. 1842 GA; and William T., b. 1844 GA. All Stricklings I've contacted outside Henry's descendants seem to share a common ancestry traced to MD in the late 17th century, but there's no place in it for Henry. Perhaps his father was a Strickland, but making this connection has not been successful either.

STRICKLAND GA in 1830 there resided a well-to-do slave-owning farmer named Irvin Strickland, b. 1780-90. Because the names of Irvin's sons and my Henry Strickling's sons overlapped, it appeared that Irvin might have been Henry's father, until I learned the identity of all of Irvin's sons and determined this could not be. Is there a connection between Irvin & Henry, or is it coincidence?
