SEXTON CEMETERY

Approximately  $9\frac{1}{2}$  miles from Columbia; leave highway #64 at Woodley's Switch turn on Public road, cross Scuppernong River and follow Public road to farm of T. H. Blake, then take path through farm to Pine-Sappling Thicket, cemetery is located in woods. Marked graves - 1; Unmarked graves 25.
